

# **PUBLIC HEARING**



## FOR PROPOSED PARKING & TRAFFIC CHANGES

Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5426 adopted June 5, 2015, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

Date/Time: Friday, June 19, at 10:00 am

Location: Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, San Francisco

(located on Van Ness Avenue between McAllister and Grove Streets)

#### **ESTABLISH - SPEED HUMPS (2)**

Sherman Street, from Folsom Street to Harrison Street

### **ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN**

Arthur Avenue, westbound, at Quint Street

### **ESTABLISH – RED ZONE**

A. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, east side, from Ortega Street to 12 feet southerly

B. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, west side, from Ortega Street to 25 feet northerly

C. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, west side, from Ortega Street to 15 feet southerly

## **ESTABLISH - RED ZONE**

Divisadero Street, west side, from Bay Street to 17 feet northerly

#### ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANY TIME FIRE LANE

Delgado Place, both sides, east of Hyde Street

#### **ESTABLISH - NO PARKING ANY TIME**

- A. Upper Terrace, west side, from 135 feet to 155 feet south of Masonic Avenue
- B. Upper Terrace, east side, from 85 feet to 110 feet north of Ashbury Terrace
- C. Upper Terrace, west side, from 5 feet to 20 feet north of Ashbury Terrace
- D. Ashbury Terrace, north side, from 5 feet to 20 feet west of Upper Terrace
- E. Ashbury Terrace, south side, from Upper Terrace to 20 feet westerly
- F. Upper Terrace, east side, from Ashbury Terrace north property line to 20 feet southerly
- G. Upper Terrace, east side, from Ashbury Terrace south property line to 20 feet northerly
- H. Upper Terrace, east side, from 55 feet to 70 feet south of Ashbury Terrace

## ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANY TIME ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING

Sunnydale Avenue, north side, from 1516 feet to 1600 feet west of Santos Street (extend sidewalk by 9 feet - removes 5 parking spaces)

Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be given final approval at the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

Buckingham Way, north side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 80 feet easterly (removes 5 parking spaces for a 7-foot wide sidewalk bulb)
