



### FOR PROPOSED PARKING & TRAFFIC CHANGES

Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5545 adopted February 19, 2016, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

#### **ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING**

Fulton Street, south side, from 5 feet to 31 feet west of Franklin Street (replaces general metered parking #301 with 4 motorcycle spaces) \*

Franklin Street, east side, from Fulton Street to 14 feet northerly (2 motorcycle spaces, between crosswalk and driveway) \*

#### **ESTABLISH – RED ZONES**

Clay Street, north side, from Mason Street to 20 feet westerly \* Clay Street, south side, from Mason Street to 16 feet westerly \*

#### **ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN**

Lafayette Street, southbound, at Howard Street, stopping the stem of the "T" intersection

Taraval Street, south side, from 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 25 feet westerly (extends existing red zone by 15 feet) \*

#### ESTABLISH - NO LEFT TURN, 4 PM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Irving Street, westbound, at 7th Avenue

#### **ESTABLISH – STOP SIGNS**

Webster Street, northbound and southbound, at Ellis Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP

## <u>ESTABLISH – 15 MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT</u>

- A. Ellis Street, between Laguna Street and "End"
- B. Willow Street, between Laguna Street and Buchanan Street
- C. Buchanan Street, between Willow Street and Eddy Street

Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

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SFMTA is holding a public hearing to consider improvements aimed to increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists and improve motorist compliance. These proposals would be constructed in early summer 2016 on Sansome Street between Bush Street and Washington Street. SFMTA proposes to:

- Change the hours of operation for the existing southbound bus, commercial vehicle, and taxi only lane from 24/7 to 7AM-8PM, everyday and allow bicycles. During all other times, regular vehicles will be able to travel southbound on Sansome Street.
- Change parking regulations along the west side of the street to match the new hours of the southbound bus, commercial vehicle, bicycle, and taxi only lane.
- Reduce driver confusion by corresponding the parking regulations with the lane regulations.
- All metered parking spaces on the west side of the street would be restricted to commercial loading between 7AM-8PM, everyday, to be consistent with the new southbound lane regulations. The hours of meter operation will not change.
- Extend the PM peak tow-away lane along the west side of Sansome Street to 8PM in order to better
  accommodate growing commuter traffic and reduce friction between southbound Muni buses and
  northbound traffic.

These proposals are a supplement to the Muni Forward project Sansome Transit Lane Extension and will help the City achieve its Transit First policy.

Sansome Street, west side from Washington to Bush streets (modifies current 3 PM TO 6PM peak hour tow-away)

### <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANY TIME, 7 AM TO 3 PM MONDAY THRU FRIDAY & 7 AM TO 8PM, SATURDAY & SUNDAY, EXCEPT COMMERCIAL LOADING</u>

- A. Sansome Street, west side, from Washington Street to Clay Street (modifies eight commercial metered spaces, Meter #503, #505, #507, #509, #511, #519, #521, #523)
- B. Sansome Street, west side, from 17 feet to 55 feet north of Sacramento Street (modifies two commercial metered spaces, Meter #401, #403)
- C. Sansome Street, west side, from Sacramento Street to Halleck Street (modifies five commercial metered spaces, Meter #319, #323, #325, #327, #329)
- D. Sansome Street, west side, from 5 feet to 198 feet south of California Street (modifies nine commercial metered spaces, Meter #207, #209, #211, #215, #217, #219, #221, #225, #223)
- E. Sansome Street, west side, from 198 feet to 242 feet south of California Street (replaces two general metered with commercial metered spaces, Meter #203, #205)
- F. Sansome Street, west side, from Pine Street to Bush Street (modifies eleven commercial metered spaces, Meter #103, #105, #107, #111, #115, #117, #121, #123, #125, #127, #129)

# ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING, 7 AM TO 3 PM MONDAY THRU FRIDAY & 7 AM TO 8PM, SATURDAY & SUNDAY EXCEPT COMMERCIAL LOADING FOR TRUCKS WITH 6 WHEELS OR MORE

Sansome Street, west side, from 55 feet to 122 feet north of Sacramento Street (modifies three 6-wheel commercial metered spaces, Meter #405, #407, #409)

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Working with San Francisco Recreation and Parks Department and San Francisco Public Works, the SFMTA is proposing to close a portion of Twin Peaks Boulevard to motor vehicles as a pilot project. This proposal would convert the western alignment to two-way operation, and close the eastern alignment to motor vehicles.


The following items have been environmentally cleared by the Planning Department on January 5, 2016, case 2016-000117ENV and will be considered at this public hearing:

### **ESTABLISH - ROAD CLOSURE, EXCEPT PEDESTRIANS AND BICYCLES**

Twin Peaks Boulevard, eastern alignment, from Christmas Tree Point Road to 1,700 feet southerly (closes existing northbound one-way portion of figure eight loop to vehicles)

#### **ESTABLISH – TWO-WAY STREET**

Twin Peaks Boulevard, western alignment, from Christmas Tree Point Road to 1,500 feet southerly (converts existing southbound one-way portion of figure eight loop to two-way operation)



Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code: For Approval Actions, the Planning Department has issued a CEQA exemption negative which viewed online determination or declaration, may be at http://www.sfplanning.org/index.aspx?page=3447.
