

## Schedule Updates: Project Agreement

PNC will provide a Fixed Price Proposal to the SFMTA in mid-December. The proposal is for the **revised bus yard** without a podium and includes updated pricing from PNC's contractor.

The SFMTA will determine if the proposal is affordable – if affordable, the team will pursue approval of the Project Agreement.



## **Yard Closure Schedule**


- Friday, Feb. 13, 2026: Last day of service out of Potrero
- Saturday, Feb. 14, 2026: Service changes into effect
  - 5/5R, 14, 22, 30, 49 routes: In service from other yards

#### **60-foot ETBs**



- Some will rotate into service via 1399 Marin
- Others into storage at MME back 4 acres

#### **40-foot ETBs**



- Some will rotate into service via Presidio
- Others into storage at MME back 4 acres



## **Public Restroom Relocation**


Prior to selecting a Lead Developer, the Neighborhood Working Group informed the principles for delivering public benefits

One of the Working Group's key priorities was a public restroom located near Franklin Square to serve parkgoers and the public at large.

To expedite the delivery of the public restroom, it has been located at the corner of 17th Street and Hampshire Street.



## **Mapped: Public Restroom**



The proposed public restroom has been relocated from Bryant Street to 17<sup>th</sup> Street, near Hampshire Street. This change will ensure that the public restroom is built as part of the bus yard and avoids coordination with the Bryant Street housing development.
