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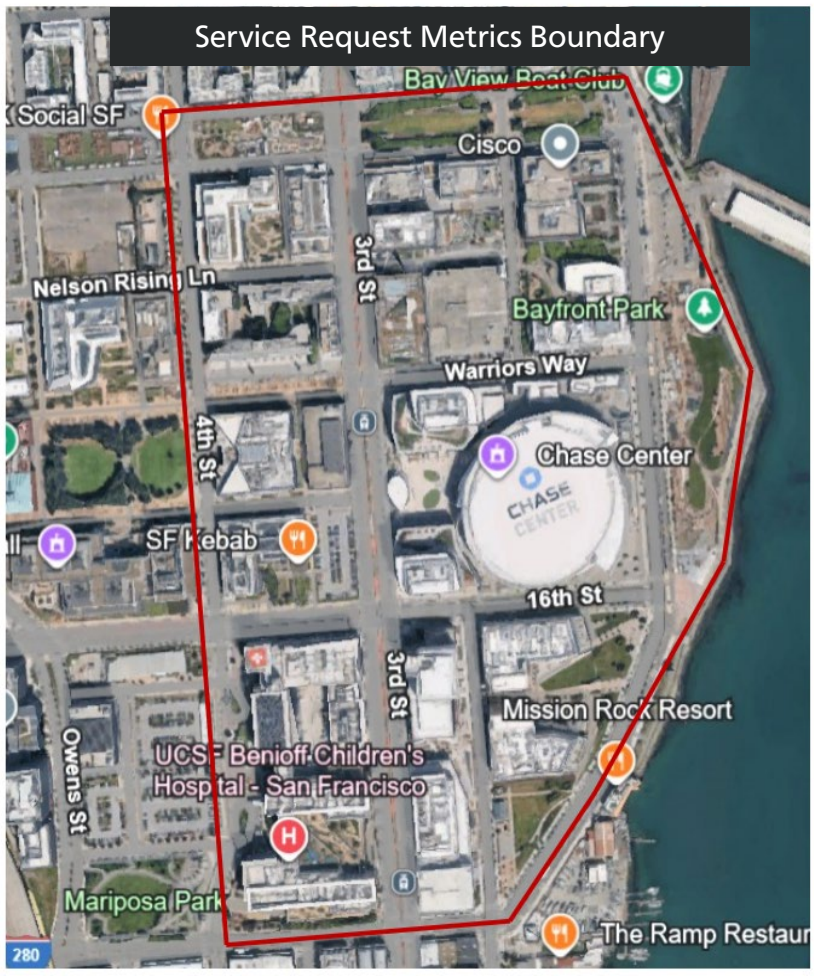

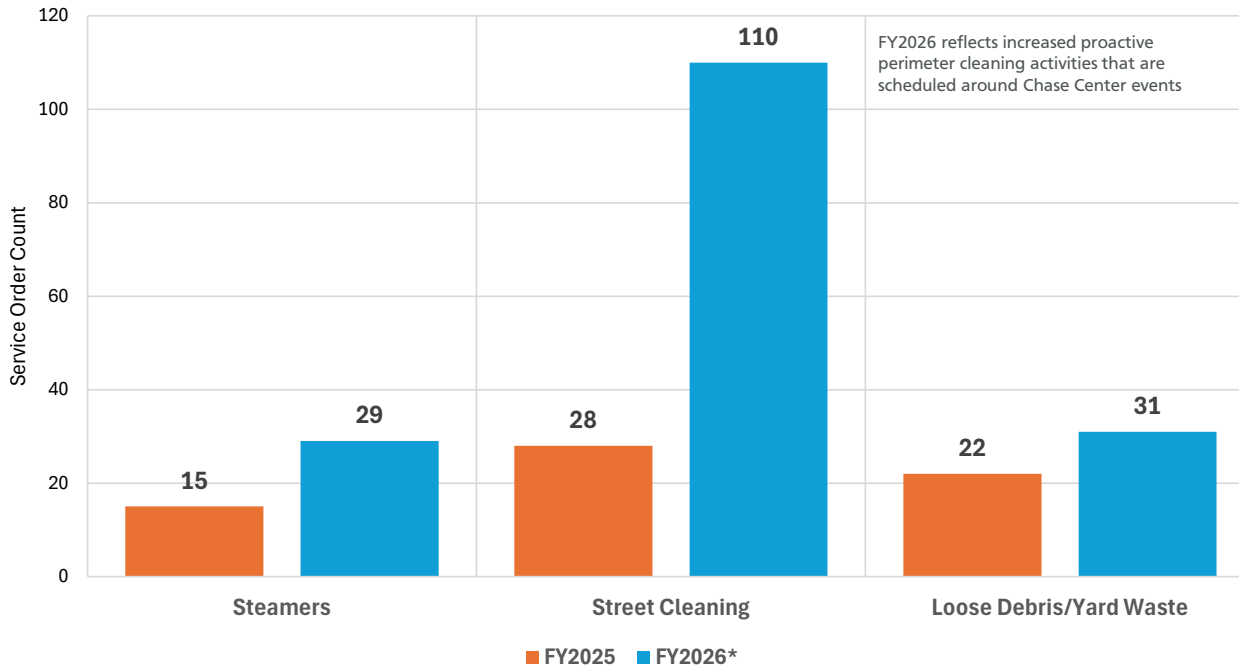


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San Francisco Mission Bay - Chase Center Completed Service Requests by Type

Enforcement and Operational Deployment

San Francisco Public Works leads enforcement of vending activities involving merchandise, goods, and pre-packaged food. The area is patrolled during daytime hours as part of routine operations, while evening events are supported through planned overtime staffing.

Supporting Agencies

- **Department of Public Health:** Leads enforcement related to prepared food vendors and food safety requirements.
- **San Francisco Police Department:** Provides support for enforcement activities and public safety.
- **San Francisco Fire Department:** Assists when safety concerns arise related to cooking equipment or open flames.
- **Port of San Francisco:** Coordinates enforcement and operational activities on Port-controlled property.
- **Intellectual Property / Brand Protection Teams:** Support enforcement efforts targeting counterfeit merchandise.

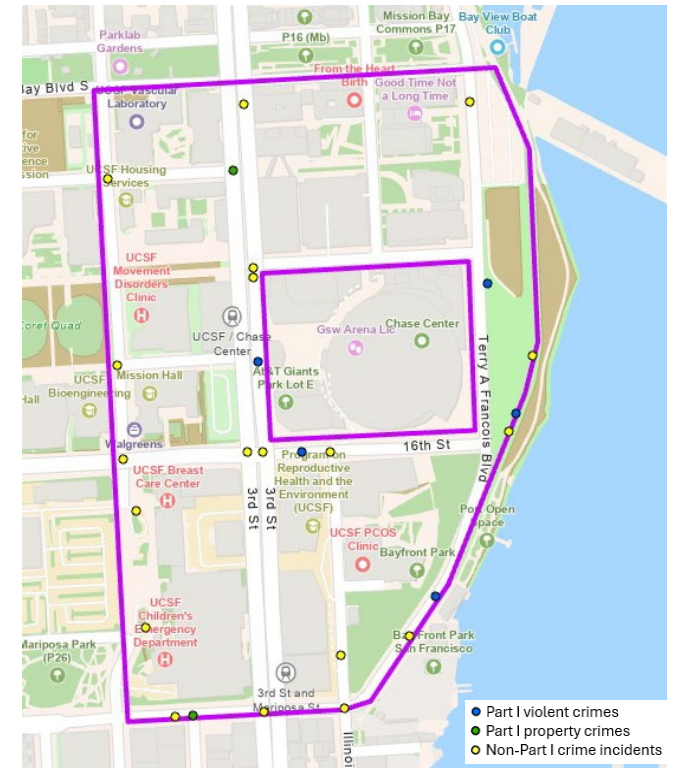

Crimes and Incidents surrounding Chase Center September 1, 2025 through March 30, 2026

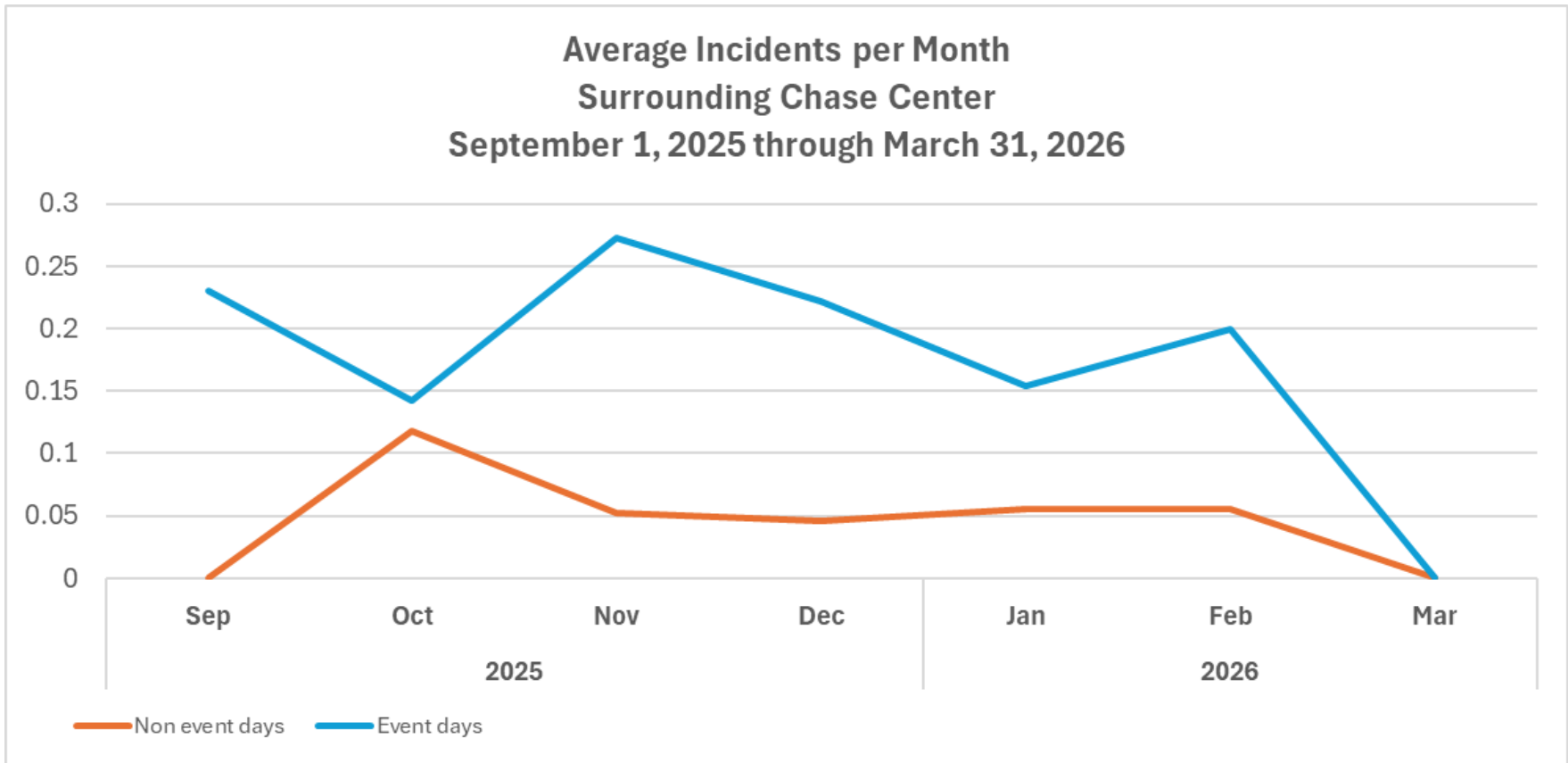
