March 4, 2016 PUBLIC HEARING RESULTS

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency held a public hearing on Friday, March 4, 2016, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the proposals listed below. This document summarizes the results of the hearing. Per Section 201 of the City Transportation Code, some items can be implemented by the authority of the City Traffic Engineer. Other items require further approval by the SFMTA Board.

1. ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

Fulton Street, south side, from 5 feet to 31 feet west of Franklin Street (replaces general metered parking #301 with 4 motorcycle spaces) Franklin Street, east side, from Fulton Street to 14 feet northerly (2 motorcycle spaces, between crosswalk and driveway)

Items will be forwarded to the City Traffic Engineer for approval and implementation.

2. ESTABLISH - RED ZONES

Clay Street, north side, from Mason Street to 20 feet westerly Clay Street, south side, from Mason Street to 16 feet westerly

3. ESTABLISH - STOP SIGN

Lafayette Street, southbound, at Howard Street, stopping the stem of the "T" intersection

Rivera Street, eastbound and westbound, at 43rd Avenue, making this intersection an allway STOP

Taraval Street, south side, from 44th Avenue to 25 feet westerly (extends existing red zone by 15 feet)
